WHO IS REPLACING IFOSTER?

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued a request for proposals for an admin for the permanent foster youth phone program. iFoster declined to submit a proposal as we have always stated our goal was to design, develop and make the pilot successful so a permanent program owned by the CPUC and their LifeLine telecom providers could be realized.

Maximus, the current LifeLine program admin, will take on running the permanent foster youth program, as well as working with youth no longer eligible for the permanent program to transition to LifeLine. While Maximus has limited child welfare experience, they have significant experience administering LifeLine, working with the CPUC, and working with telecom carriers.

HOW DO WE CONTACT THEM?

Maximus has told us they will be ready to take on their administrative role starting July 31, 2024. Prior to July 31, 2024, new applications, phone number change requests, phone incident reports, and phone replacement requests will continue to be added to the wait list. For now, you can continue to reach out to iFoster to be added to the wait list.

Starting July 31, 2024, Maximus will be ready to receive inquiries and applications from youth directly and will begin addressing these wait lists. Prior to the end of July 2024, Maximus will be providing FAQs and other materials detailing how to reach and work with them.
