

iFoster's Peers Paving the Path

Free, lived-experience support to promote stability and long-term success

iFoster pairs Medi-Cal Certified Peer Support Specialists—professionals with lived foster care experience—with eligible youth to co-create personalized plans for self-sufficiency. Participants receive coordinated, wraparound support across healthcare, behavioral health, housing, education, employment and social services to promote stability and long-term success.

What Youth Receive

Enhanced Case Management (ECM) and Community Supports - Housing Trio services that cover housing navigation, housing deposits/set up costs and sustaining services that include:

- Personalized goal planning
- 1:1 sessions at least twice a month with a Peer Support Specialist
- Hands-on help enrolling in government benefits and navigating community supports that support wellness, stability, education, employment and career goals
- Assistance with needs such as clothing and housing (services/funds to help obtain and maintain housing), technology, and transportation
- Monthly financial or gift rewards for progress and achievements

Who Is Eligible?

Must be enrolled in an eligible Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan (iFoster staff can advise) and be a:

- Child or youth involved in Child Welfare (up to age 26)
- Child or youth transitioning from incarceration
- Unaccompanied child/homeless youth



Get Started Today

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How It Works

1. **Get Matched:** Paired with a Peer Support Specialist
2. **Meet Regularly:** Set goals, track progress, and adjust as life changes—at least twice a month
3. **Stay Supported:** Services continue as long as needed while enrolled in a Medicaid Managed Care Plan (MCP)
